ENGIE Energy Access is the leading off-grid, Pay-As-You-Go (PAYGo) and mini-grid solutions provider in Africa. They strive towards meeting the UN's SDG7 goal of universal energy access by serving the remotest households on the world's fastest growing continent. They have already transformed 6.5 million lives in 9 countries, and aim to impact 20 million by 2025. Access to electricity is a human right. Yet over 600 million people in Sub-Saharan Africa lack access to clean, safe and affordable energy. Many families have to rely on dangerous, dirty energy sources like kerosene or unreliable energy products with no after-sales care. ENGIE is changing this, one household at a time.
